REGISTRATION

Register early in order to guarantee your child a summer filled with lots of excitement, new friends and **FUN!** All registration forms and information can be found at www.qopacademy.org. Please drop off all early-registration forms to the Academy's front office or mail in your completed form to Queen of Peace Catholic Academy, 10900 SW 24th Avenue, Gainesville, FL 32607. Registration paperwork must be received in order to guarantee your spot!

DROP-OFF, PICK-UP & CAMP PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Drop-Off –

- Camp drop-off is located at the entrance of the Gym and starts at **7:30am**
- Sign your camper in on the attendance sheet and write in the time of drop-off
- Have your camper put their lunch on the labeled carts
- Campers then should proceed to the gym where they will be directed to the appropriate area by camp staff

Pick-Up –

- All campers must be signed out of Summer Camp by a parent or authorized pick-up person. If your child is being picked up by someone other than a parent, please write the name(s) of these individuals on the registration form accordingly
- All persons picking up a camper must present a photo ID at pick-up
- Campers who are not picked-up by **4:00pm** will be signed into Aftercare and charged an additional fee
- Campers staying for Aftercare will be dismissed from the gym up until **6:00pm**. If a camper is picked up late, a fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each additional 15 minutes

Making Camp Payments –

- **Queen of Peace Catholic Academy families** must pay all camp fees through FACTS. If you will be attending QPCA as a new student in the Fall, please check with the Summer Camp Director to ensure that your FACTS account is set up to make camp payments. **Cash or checks from QPCA families will not be accepted!**
- **Non-QPCA families** must pay camp fees with a check made payable to Queen of Peace Catholic Academy. **No cash will be accepted!**

MAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- **Families of Queen of Peace Catholic Academy:** All Summer Camp fees **must** be paid through FACTS! **No cash or checks will be accepted!** Camp charges will be posted to your FACTS account the Wednesday following each week of camp.
- **Non-QPCA Families:** Camp fees can be paid via check. All checks must be made payable to *Queen of Peace Catholic Academy*. **No cash will be accepted!**
- **Lunch, Snacks & Water Bottles:** Please send your camper with a lunch, snacks and a re-fillable water bottle labeled with their name. Watch for our catered food lunch options which will be advertised at the beginning of Summer Camp and can be signed up for weekly at the sign in/out desk. Food options offered by the camp can be paid weekly with cash only.
- **Sunscreen & Clothing:** Please be sure to have your camper wear sunscreen and tennis shoes to *ALL* camps. Camp classes may go outside for activities. Also be sure that your camper comes to camp wearing clothes that are okay to get messy/dirty. Campers are permitted to wear a bathing suit for the Wild, Wacky Water Party at the end of the summer.
- **Art Projects:** Campers will make art/craft projects during Summer Camp. Be sure that all projects are taken home at pick-up on a daily basis. Projects will be located in the front of the gym with your camper's name on them.
- **Lost & Found:** We do have a Summer Camp Lost & Found that is located inside the gym. Queen of Peace Academy is not responsible for any lost items. All lost and found items will be discarded on the last day of Summer Camp so please plan to look for your belongings accordingly.
- **Bringing Toys From Home:** Toys will not be needed during any sessions of Summer Camp. Please refrain from sending your camper with any additional toys or stuffed animals. Queen of Peace Academy is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- **Misconduct:** Any camper who is misbehaving will be directed to the Summer Camp Director and the appropriate action will be taken. If such behavior continues, parents will be contacted and the camper may be asked not to return to camp for the safety of other campers and staff.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- ***Does my child have to go to camp all day?***

No, your child may take any of the classes offered individually. Please refer to the registration form for all dates, times and fees.

- ***Can I register and pay for a class on the same day that camp begins?***

Yes, however some classes may be limited in space and thus Pre-registration is highly recommended in order to guarantee your spot!

- ***Will classes fill quickly?***

Some classes are very popular and will fill up quickly and may have a cap as to how many campers can participate per session. To ensure that your child is placed in the desired classes, registration should be turned in ASAP. All children will be placed in classes on a first come, first serve basis.

- ***If my child is going to camp every day this summer, do I need to pay for the entire summer at the time of registration?***

No, you do not have to pay for the entire summer all at once and are able to pay for camp weekly.
