



General Information –

- Summer Camp starts on Monday, June 9th and ends on Thursday, July 31st.
- **There will not be Summer Camp on Friday, July 4th.**

Please note that this week of camp will not be prorated.

What to Bring –

- Lunch/Snacks (Unless purchasing at camp)
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- Be sure all personal items are clearly labeled with the camper's name. Items will be held for a week after Academy Camp ends at that time all leftover belongings will be donated or discarded.

Camp Fees & Payments –

- **All participants must be pre-registered and pre-paid for each week by midnight of the Friday prior to the week your child will be attending. No walk ups will be accepted. Weekly fees will not be prorated.**
- QPCA families must pre-pay fees via FACTS. Please be sure to pre-pay the amount necessary per your registration paperwork even if you do not see the fee applied to your Summer Camp account in FACTS.
- Non-QPCA families must pay all fees by check made payable to *Queen of Peace Catholic Academy* at the time of registration. You may mail your registration paperwork with your check to 10900 SW 24th Ave, Gainesville, FL 32607; or you may drop off your paperwork and check to the Academy Office. If the Academy Office is closed, you may use the mail slot at the front of the Church Office building to drop off your registration paperwork and check.
- If your child is not pre-registered and pre-paid for a week of camp, they will not be allowed to enter the gym.
- Should your child be unable to attend a pre-paid week of camp, please call 352-448-4557 as soon as possible to free up that spot for another child.
- QPCA campers who have paid, but are unable to attend for unforeseen reasons, and provide notice within an appropriate time, may receive a credit in FACTS at the discretion of the camp director.

Drop Off & Pick-Up Procedures –

- All participants will be signed in for camp at the desk in the front of the gym.
- **Parents will not be permitted to enter the gym after drop-off.**
- Camp drop-off starts at 7:30am. Academy Camp is not responsible for your child prior to this time.
- All participants must be signed in and out of camp by a parent or authorized pick-up person. If your child is being picked up by someone other than a parent, please be sure these names are listed on your child's registration form.
- Photo ID will be required for pick-up and any changes to authorized pick-ups must be submitted in writing.
- All lunches/snacks/personal belongings should be clearly labeled with your child's name. The Academy Camp is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items. Any items left behind by the end of camp will be held for a week then donated or discarded.

- All artwork goes home on Fridays and must be picked up at the front of the gym prior to the end of day. Artwork not taken home by the end of week will be discarded.
- Participants who are not picked up by 4:00pm will go to Aftercare and will be charged additional fees.
- Aftercare ends at 6:00pm and if a participant is picked up after 6:00pm, a fee of \$2 per minute will be charged.

Weekly Lunch Options – Lunch is \$5 per day (cash only)

- *All lunches are served with a juice box and side item (chips & cookie)*
- Snacks and drinks are not provided - The Candy Shop will be open during snack time for campers to purchase items.

Medications - The parent/guardian is required to hand-deliver all medications to staff on a daily basis. Please do not have it delivered by your child. Staff will only accept one daily dose of medication that is in the original container with the child's name, name of the physician, and directions for administering on the printed label.

Illness and Injury - Please tell your children to inform staff if he/she starts to feel sick or experience illness while at camp. A parent/guardian will be contacted for pick-up.

Behavior Management - At the discretion of the Academy Camp, a child may be asked to suspend or withdraw from camp for reasons regarding their behavior. It is up to staff to determine whether an offense is minor or serious. No refund will be issued for suspension or withdrawal from camp including pre-paid specialty camps.

Class Activities - Activities are planned with a theme in mind. Due to various circumstances, all activities are subject to last minute changes/cancellations.

Middle School (R6th-R9th) - Group Level

- Academy Camp will be opening up a group for rising 6th graders - rising 9th graders.
